

## David Wolfgram

David Wolfgram has joined Zimcode's board of Advisors. His primary focus will be to provide strategic direction for the TeamRunner restaurant platform. Mr. Wolfgram currently serves as President and Chief Executive Officer of Mediterranean Cuisine Operating Company LLC (MCOC). MCOC owns and operates forty six Daphne's California Greek locations and two Yalla Mediterranean restaurants. Yalla Mediterranean is a new fast casual concept celebrating the bold flavors of the Eastern Mediterranean featuring local and organic produce and responsibly raised meat, fish and poultry whenever possible.

In 1991, Wolfgram co-founded Maggiano's Little Italy and the Corner Bakery Café, a LEYE restaurant concept. In 1996, Corner Bakery Café was acquired by Brinker International, a Dallas, Texas based publicly owned restaurant corporation (NYSE-EAT). Wolfgram served as President and lead the Corner Bakery Café expansion across the United States until 2003, when he left Brinker International to start the development of **Go Roma Italian Kitchen™**. At the time of his departure, Corner Bakery Café had grown to 80 cafes, generating \$140 million in annual sales.

For the creation of **Go Roma Italian Kitchen™** an exciting quick-casual restaurant concept, Wolfgram partnered with Yorgo Koutsogiorgas, Russell Bry and Jeff Drake, three restaurant industry veterans with whom he had worked throughout his years at LEYE and Brinker International.

In 2004, Wolfgram partnered with GESD Capital Partners, a San Francisco based private equity firm and assumed the role of CEO of **Boudin Bakeries** where he introduced the **Boudin SF Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner/Sourdough fast casual concept**. Founded in the early days of the Gold Rush in 1849, **Boudin Bakery** is the creator of the Original San Francisco Sourdough French Bread.

Wolfgram then served as the President and Chief Executive Officer of **Black Angus Steakhouse**. Black Angus Steakhouses, LLC is based in Los Altos, CA. Owned by Versa Capital Management, Inc., the Black Angus brand has been serving up legendary steaks since 1964 and has 44 restaurants on the West Coast located in California, Washington, Arizona, Alaska, New Mexico, and Hawaii.
