

## Kurt Bevacqua

### Sports Commentator and Retired Major League Baseball Player

Kurt Bevacqua reached the pinnacle of the baseball world by playing in the major leagues for 15 years, half of that time spent with the San Diego Padres, where he achieved his greatest success, twice leading the National League in pinch hitting, and leading the Padres in Home Runs and RBI's in the 1984 World Series, where he was named the Padres MVP. He also was named to the Padres All-Time team in 2000.

Upon his retirement in 1986 Kurt immediately started working for NBC sports as a national commentator for the NBC game of the week pre-game show in New York with Marv Albert. Kurt later teamed with John Miller in doing the NBC back-up game of the week. Kurt also worked for ESPN, ABC and became the host of the San Diego Padres Pre-game and Post-game radio talk shows on the Padres flagship station in San Diego which at that time was KFMB's 760 AM. Kurt now does the Padres pre-game social hour television show on Fox Sports West and also Padres pre and post game radio on The Mighty 1090 AM.

Kurt is an avid golfer and fierce competitor...from 2001 thru 2006, Kurt was President and Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Celebrity Players Tour, a celebrity golf tour that raised over \$8,000,000 during its existence playing in charity events all across the US and in the Caribbean. Kurt resides in La Costa, CA. with Cynthia his wife of 18 years and their 2 boys, Garrett and Brody.
